RE: Kiwetinohk Opal Transmission Project – Project Update

In July 2023, ATCO Electric Ltd. (ATCO) sent you information about the Kiwetinohk Opal Transmission Project (the Project). The Project is located in Fox Creek, Alberta and will connect a customer's new generation facility to the electrical grid. This letter provides an update on the Project status and construction schedule.

Project Details

On November 24, 2023, ATCO filed a Facility Application (Proceeding No. 28658) for this Project to the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC). On February 23, 2024, the AUC approved ATCO's Facility Application and granted ATCO permits to construct and licences to operate the Project.

ATCO's approved plans include:

- Construction of approximately two kilometres (km) of single-circuit 144 kilovolt (kV) transmission line (to be called 7LA199); and
- Modifications to the existing 144 kV transmission line 7L199 to accommodate the connection of 7LA199, including upgrading seven km of line in the existing alignment and relocating approximately 500 metres of line to a new alignment.

Construction Schedule

Construction of this Project has been delayed until 2025. We will notify directly affected landholders with a construction schedule once we get closer to the construction start date and plans are finalized.
